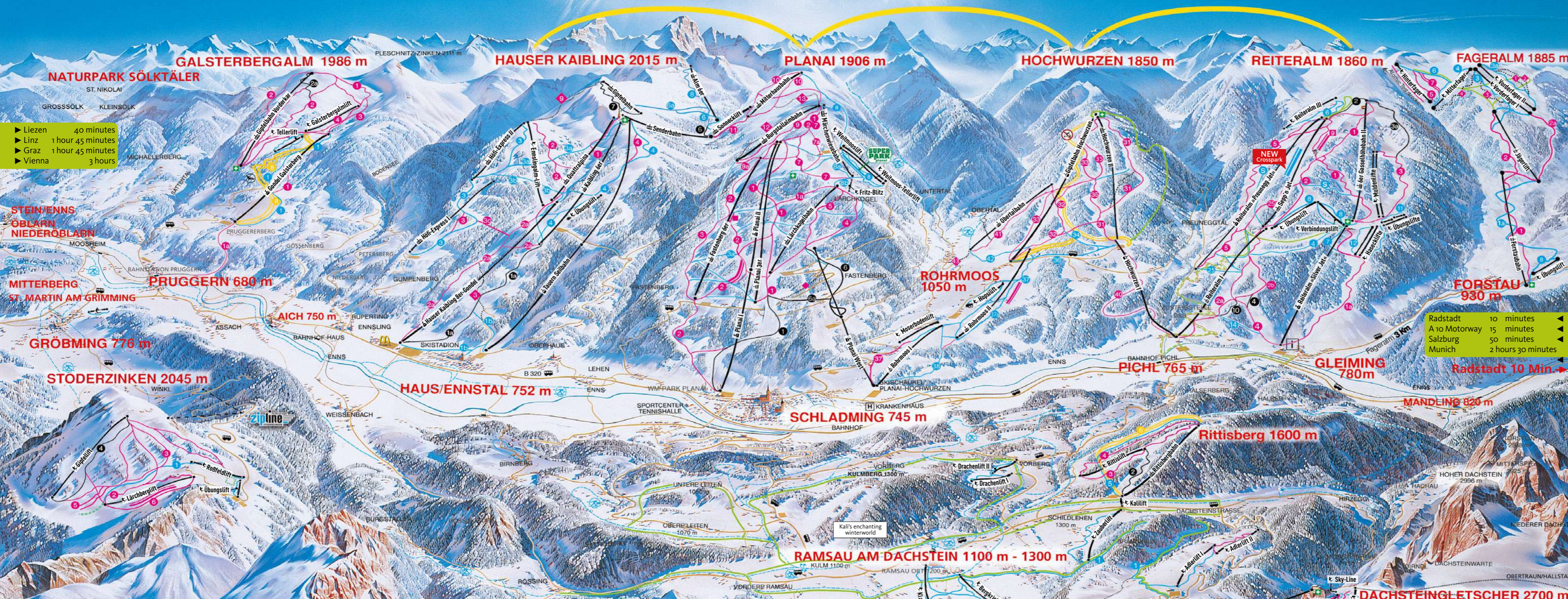

THE SCHLADMING-DACHSTEIN REGION

One of the largest ski areas in Austria, it includes the Dachstein Glacier at an altitude of 2,700 m above sea level. All of the pistes descending from the mountains into the valleys may be covered with artificial snow if required. Enjoy 185 fine kilometres of pistes, 76 modern cable cars carry you uphill quickly & over 90 inviting lodges await you! ALL ski passes (incl. day tickets) are issued in the form of Key Cards (non-contact ski pass). Your € 3.- deposit will be returned when you return your undamaged Key Card to the ski ticket counter. You may obtain information about prices of all the types of ski passes, such as half-day and multi-day tickets from the ski counters on the mountains themselves, via the internet or by telephone. Out of respect for the natural environment, we would ask all visitors to keep to the prepared and designated pistes which are clearly marked out.
